

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Clean the Mount by flushing away dirt with fresh water and/or wiping down the assemblies with a clean, damp cloth. If used in a salt water environment, flushing with fresh water and drying after use is recommended. If used extensively in a salt water environment, lightly lubricate stainless steel parts as needed.

Horizontal adjustment and release mechanisms that are not kept free from debris may bind, and the assembly may not lock the mount into the up or down position. Lubricate lightly as needed. Check the replaceable wear pads on the mounting interface. If worn, replace with a flat head screwdriver as illustrated

Periodically, and after any cleaning with an air hose, apply a small amount of non-hydroscopic grease to the NVG Flip Release Bar Notch and press the NVG Release Button several times to lubricate.




